## Crocheted Cotton Squares

*This pattern makes small cotton squares approx.* 6" *x* 6"

Supplies Needed:

- Crochet hook: Size H, I, or J
- Worsted weight cotton yarn
- Scissors
- Blunt Tapestry Needle to weave in ends



Instructions:

Chain 24.

1st Row: 3 DC in 4th ch from hook. \*skip 3 ch, 1 sc in next ch. Ch 3, 3 DC, in same sc. repeat across from \* ending 1 sc in last ch. Ch 3, turn.

2nd Row: 3 DC in 1st sc. \*in next ch 3 space work 1 sc. ch 3, 3 DC\* repeat from \* across ending sc in top of ch 3 of previous row. Ch 3, turn.

Repeat Row 2 until you have 11 rows. DO NOT FINISH OFF!

ENDING: Continue to work pattern on the 3 straight sides making 1 sc, ch 3, 3 DC in the same place they were made.
